### 'LUME: IMAXES DUNHA TERRA QUE ARDE' (Photo exhibit **Exposición fotográfica**)

*Afundación*, the social work of Abanca, in collaboration with the OLLO collective and with the participation of the USC, presents in Santiago its new project, "Lume. Imaxes dunha terra que arde". It is a street photography exhibition made up of a total of 13 panels with professional photographs, taken over the last 15 years in Galicia, with the aim of addressing one of the most worrying problems of Galician ecosystems: forest fires. Through the images and audiovisual pieces, "Lume. Imaxes dunha terra que arde", a narrative about forest fires is traced that appeals to the viewer, generating questions and answers, in a sensitive but reflexive way, about the causes and consequences of the fires.

*Afundación*, la obra social de Abanca, en colaboración con el colectivo OLLO y con la participación de la USC, presenta en Santiago su nuevo proyecto «**Lume. Imaxes dunha terra que arde**». Se trata de una muestra fotográfica de calle conformada por un total de 13 paneles con fotografías profesionales, realizadas durante los últimos 15 años en Galicia, con el objetivo de abordar una de las problemáticas más preocupantes de los ecosistemas gallegos: los incendios forestales. A través de las imágenes y piezas audiovisuales, "**Lume. Imaxes dunha terra que arde**" traza una narrativa sobre los incendios forestales que apela al espectador, generando en él preguntas y respuestas, de una manera sensible pero reflexiva, acerca de las causas y de las consecuencias de los incendios.

### 'INCENDIOS' (Art installation **Instalación artística**)

Starting from our recent history, Miguel Mosquera (Ourense, 1953) builds an exhibition project in which, following a heterogeneous and conceptual strategy, a mixture of different elements and textures, he elaborates a discourse that navigates the path between data, forms and feelings awakened in our consciousness and collective memory after the passage of the fire. The proposal of this exhibition invites several critical reflections. On the one hand, it opens the door to rethink our own relationship with the natural environment, and also, as it could not be otherwise, our way of building ourselves as a society, growing with our backs to our natural spaces and promoting these illusory dichotomies society-nature, rural-urban world or traditional culture-contemporary culture.

Partiendo de nuestra reciente historia, Miguel Mosquera (Ourense, 1953) construye un proyecto expositivo en el que, siguiendo un heterogéneo y estrategia conceptual, mezcla de diferentes elementos y texturas, elabora un discurso que navega el camino entre los datos, las formas y los sentimientos despertados en nuestra conciencia y memoria colectiva tras el paso del fuego. La propuesta de esta exposición invita a varias reflexiones críticas. Por un lado, abre la puerta a repensar nuestra propia relación con el entorno natural, y también, como no podía ser de otra manera, nuestra forma de construirnos como sociedad, creciendo de espaldas a nuestros espacios naturales y fomentando esas dicotomías ilusorias sociedad-naturaleza, mundo rural-mundo urbano o cultura tradicional-cultura contemporánea.
